It has experienced a new wave of explosive growth in recent decades under the leadership and vision of Pastors Tommy Barnett and Luke Barnett. In November 2015, the church became the Valley's newest multi-site megachurch with the opening of its Scottsdale campus, and then in February 2016, Dream City Church merged with Community Church of Joy in Glendale, AZ, a union that expanded Dream City Church's reach into the West Valley and took an unprecedented step toward a movement that will break down denominational walls to reach more people for Christ.

The official conference hotel will be Pointe Hilton Tapatio Cliffs Resort. Surrounded by views of the mountains, Pointe Hilton Tapatio Cliffs Resort is a 20-minute drive north of downtown Phoenix. The Falls Water Village boasts two pools, waterfalls, a water slide, and private cabanas. There are six more pools on site, a full-service spa, and award-winning 18-hole Troon Golf Course. Their dining options include an award-winning restaurant.
